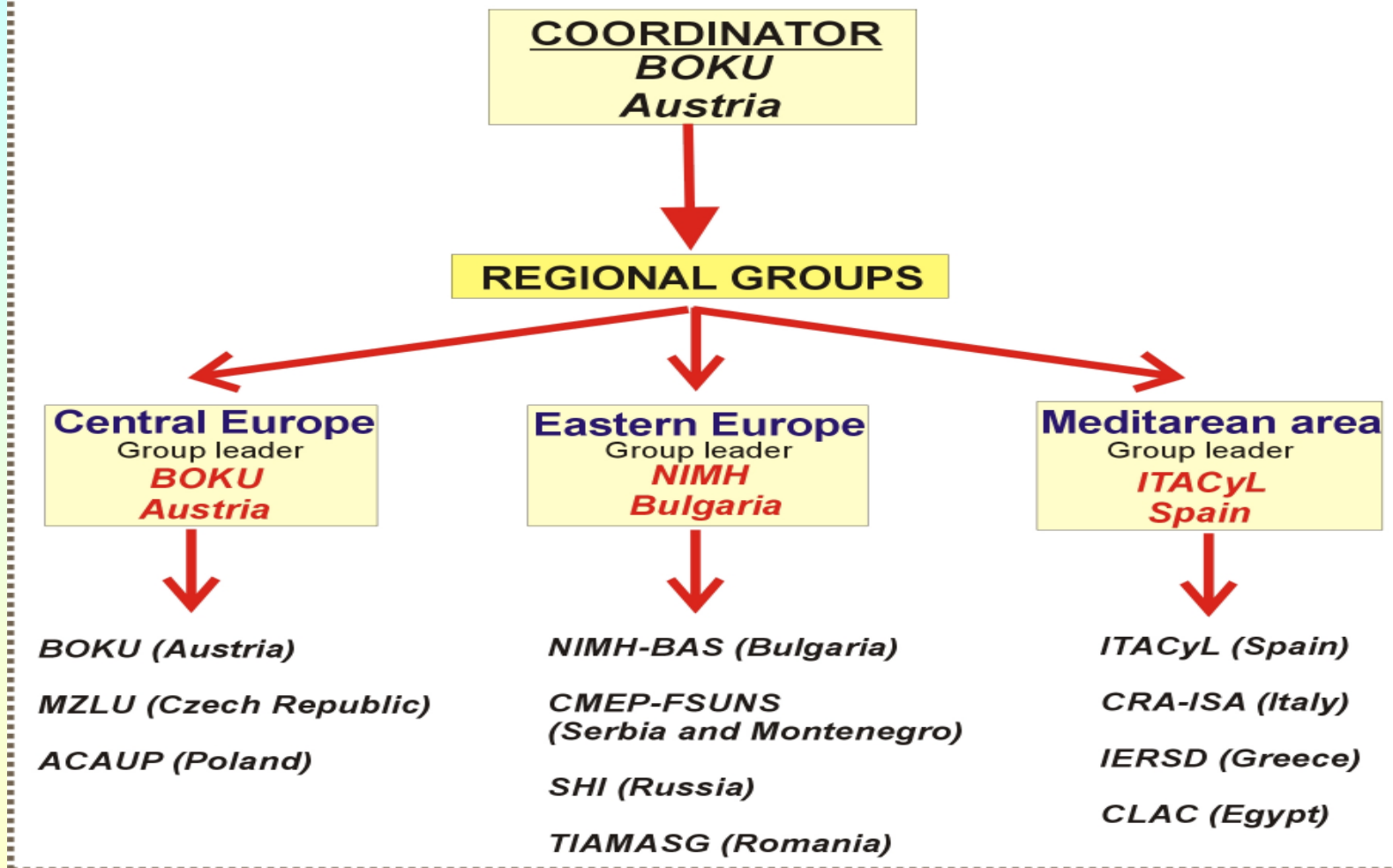

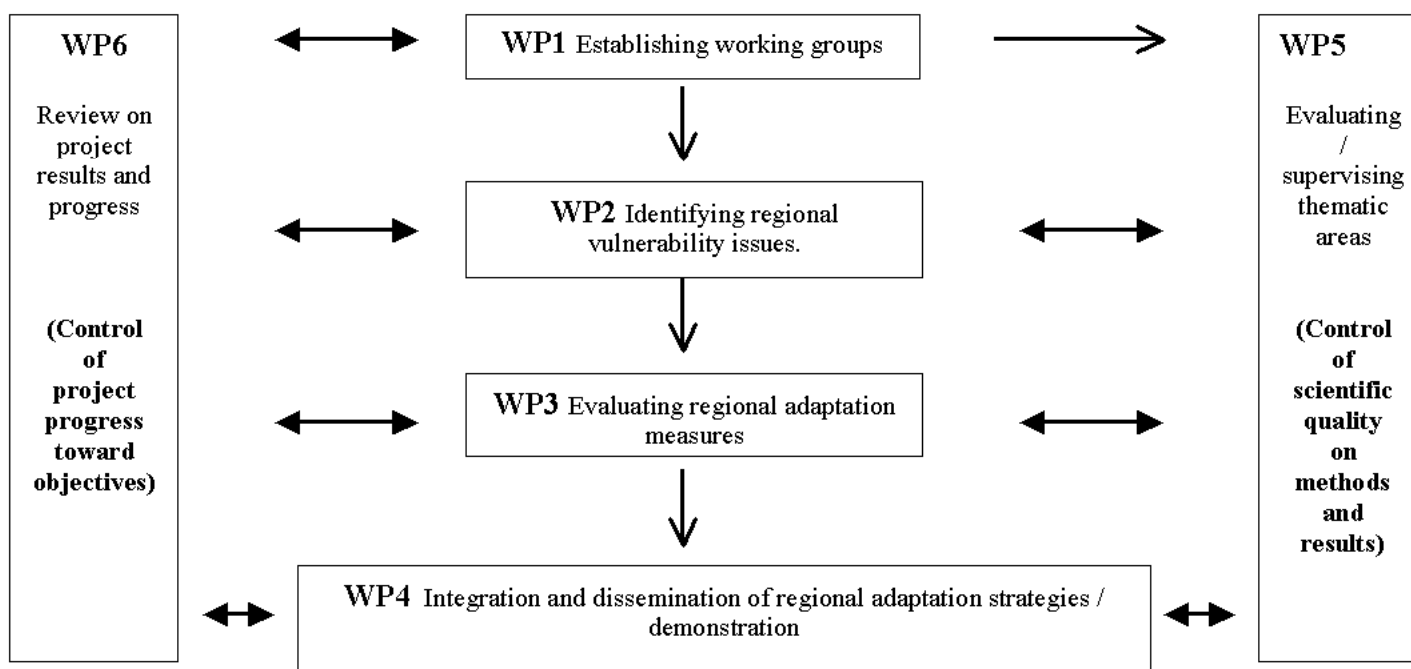


## ORGANIZATION STRUCTURE of ADAGIO



Adaptation strategies at the national, regional and farm level will be evaluated in the SSA. They are crucial for sustainable production of farming systems, which includes socio-economic as well as ecological aspects

- **Key challenges of ADAGIO**

- **Combining Bottom-up and Top-Down approach**

- **Highlight differences between regions / problem areas:**

- Montains vs. flat lands
- Developed vs. Developing regions
  - Humid vs. arid regions
- Describing types of vulnerabilities
- Are spatial /interannual variabilities in risks probablity increasing
  - Socio-economic interactions
- Regional focus of adaptation : increasing positive effects or reducing risks ?
